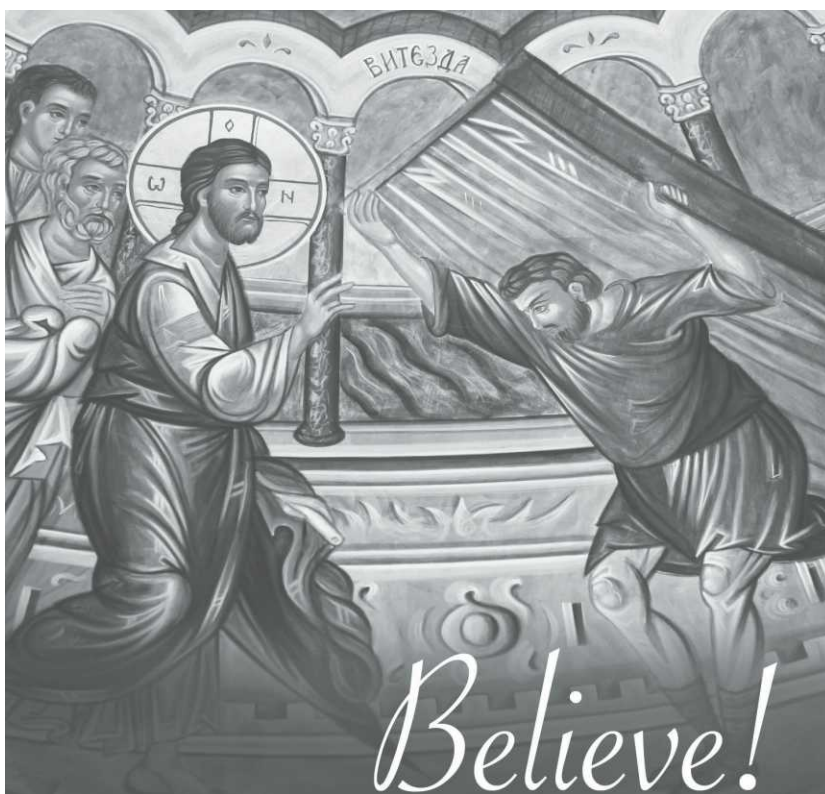

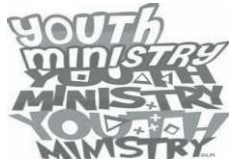

**The HHS Mandate:****An Attack on Rights of Conscience**

Never before has federal law forced citizens to purchase what violates their deeply held beliefs and ethical convictions. But now the current Administration is forcing Christians to act as if pregnancy were a disease to be prevented at all costs. For many Americans, this means choosing between violating our consciences and forgoing health care -- literally an unconscionable dilemma.

Our country’s longstanding laws protecting conscience rights must now apply fully to the implementation of health care reform. For that we need more than rule-making, we need a law. The bishops are urging Congress to support the “Respect for Rights of Conscience Act” in light of the new HHS rule and the “unprecedented threat to religious freedom” it poses. ## Fasting and Abstinence

- Fasting means eating only one normal-sized meal and two small meals, with no snacks.
- Abstinence means eating no meat. Milk, eggs, and fish are fine.
- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both abstinence and fasting.
- Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence.
- Those 14 and older are required to abstain from meat.
- Those 18-59 are required to fast. Those with special medical conditions that prevent fasting are excluded.
- Ash Wednesday is 46 days before Easter, but Lent is considered 40 days long, because Sundays are not counted as days of Lent. The reason? Fasting was considered inappropriate on Sunday, the day commemorating the Resurrection of Jesus.

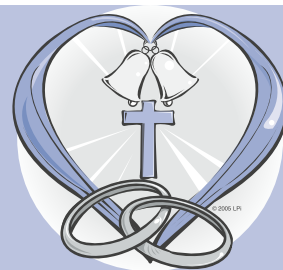
## Ayuno y abstinencia

- Ayunar significa comer sólo una comida de tamaño normal y dos comidas pequeñas, sin bocadillos.
- Abstinencia significa no comer carne. Leche, huevos y pescado están bien.
- El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de abstinencia y ayuno.
- Los Viernes durante la Cuaresma son días de abstinencia. Personas de 14 años y mayores están obligados a abstenerse de comer carne.
- Aquellos de 18-59 están obligados a ayunar. Las personas con condiciones médicas especiales que impiden el ayuno son excluidos.
- Miércoles de Ceniza es 46 días antes de la Pascua, pero la Cuaresma se considera 40 días porque los domingos no se cuentan como días de la Cuaresma. ¿La razón? El ayuno se considera inapropiado en domingo, el día que se conmemora la Resurrección de Jesús.
