EVIL CONFRONTED

Today's Gospel pictures Jesus constantly reaching out in the healing ministry. Whether it be healing the sick, casting out demons or listening to people's woes. Today Jesus heals someone close to him, Peter's mother-in-law. She had an unknown illness in which she was overtaken with a fever. Jesus' healing compassion reached out to her by grasping her hand and helping her up. Isn't that what our healing sacraments of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick are all about? The mystery of Christ's healing presence heals and forgives in sign and action in the Sacraments. When Peter's mother-in-law was healed she got up and served. So too when we are well and our life is well balanced we are able to serve others.

ANOTHER STORY

One day a friend visited Henri Matisse, a French artist. Noticing how filled with stress his friend was, Matisse, said, "Andre", you must find the artichokes in your life: Then he led his friend to a patch of artichokes in the garden and said, "Each morning after I have worked a while, I come

my work." We can ask ourselves how do I let the quiet presence of Jesus speak to me in a place of quiet that can relax me and give me new perspective toward my work?

REFLECTION TIME

Consider how important prayer was for Jesus that enabled him to keep on doing what he understood his mission in life was. Do we have a balanced life: work and prayer, time for family, friends and sleep? When do we make time for some quiet in our lives with so much noise, work, activities bustling all around us? When do we give God time to break into our thoughts? Maybe a Lenten practice would be to come to church 10 minutes earlier for some quiet prayer before the Blessed Sacrament for a more balanced life. Or can we sit quietly in our living room for a few minutes without immediately turning on the noise of the TV? May our time of quiet show us the face of the Father, who wishes us to be fully alive in the Spirit. We ask for health that we need to do the work God has called us to do and so doing the Father's will.
