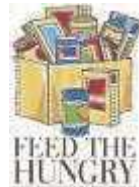
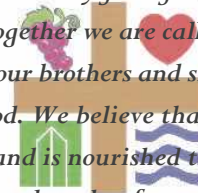
2012 ANNUAL DIOCESAN APPEAL
