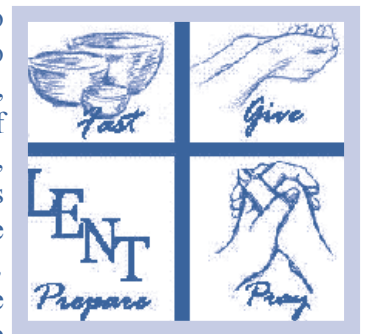

Business as usual. Same old, same old. Same stuff, different day.

These expressions should not describe what begins for us on Wednesday – February 22 and concludes on Thursday – April 5. **That 40-day period should be far from “business as usual,” “same old, same old,” or “same stuff, different day.”** It’s the Season of Lent. It is not time for the ordinary and the routine, but for the extraordinary and the outstanding.

Lent is “basic training,” if you will. It is a time to get back to the basics of our faith. It is a time for conversion, a turning around, a turning back to God. Pope Benedict XVI describes “conversion” as not so much a turning back to an idea or to following rules and regulations but a turning back to a Person, the Person of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior, the Only-Begotten Son of God who loves us so much that He came down from heaven, emptying Himself, giving His life totally and completely, allowing His Body to be broken and every drop of His Precious Blood to be poured out for the forgiveness of our sins and our eternal salvation. Lent is a time for deepening our friendship with God in Christ, and the Holy Spirit is so very eager to help us with that!

Wow! Think about it. That is an awesome reality. No wonder the Church encourages us to take 40 days to think about it, reflect on it, contemplate and absorb it, trying to fathom the great and unconditional love of God for us ... weak, broken, sinful, and at times, stubborn and disobedient people. The Church offers us the tools we need to make this turn-around ... they are the usual and time-honored, time-tested tools: *prayer, fasting, and works of mercy.* Although these 3 are interconnected and never separated, let’s talk a little about each one for more clarity:



Prayer. The greatest prayer is the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. That’s why we have daily Mass at various times during the week during this Lent. We hope you find our schedule convenient, but neighboring parishes will welcome you as well if their times are more suitable for your work schedule. How about Stations of the Cross? Make it a “family affair!” Don’t forget Grace Before Meals, a family Rosary once a week, prayers before bed, a morning offering ... all ways to increase our communication and communion with God. Certainly don’t forget about going to Confession!

Fasting. What the Church actually requires by law is minimal. How about “giving up” not only food and beverages but other things and activities that distract us, fill our time, entertain us and sometimes overwhelm us? Be creative. You might surprise yourselves with some good ideas for fasting.

Works of mercy. There are all kinds of people who need our compassion and our help. Let’s keep our eyes open for ways to be of service to others, loving our neighbor as ourselves. Don’t forget ... “charity begins at home!” Sometimes we don’t have to look too far to see those who need our love and care.

May this Lent truly be a rich and blessed time for us at Saint Philip’s. Never business as usual ... but God’s business, something new and fresh, revitalizing and renewing us in Christ. God bless you!

If you've been thinking of changing your bathroom colors or getting new bed linens for the kid's room, we have a place for your old sheets and towels. We will try to condense the collection to a single weekend and transport all the collected white goods to Providence at one time.
